February 21, 2024

Flood Activity

California

- Flash Flood Warnings remain in effect in Los Angeles as a multiday atmospheric river storm continues to pound the Golden State with heavy rain that has caused rivers to rage and landslides that sent massive boulders tumbling down mountainsides onto busy roads below.
- The relentless precipitation that has led to issues up and down the state will be coming to an end on Wednesday, but not after dumping additional heavy rain in Southern California, including Los Angeles, which is seeing its fourth-wettest February on record and its 10th-wettest month of all time.
- So far, downtown Los Angeles has seen 12.33 inches of rain in February, more than an inch below the top total of 13.68 inches set in February 1998.
- The final round of heavy precipitation is currently occurring over Los Angeles and Southern California, which will only add to the rain totals already recorded over the past several days.
- Flash Flood Watches remain in effect across parts of Central and Southern California, including the cities of Bakersfield, Fresno, Santa Barbara, Temecula and San Diego.
- Flash Flood Warnings remain in effect until 9 a.m. PST for the downtown Los Angeles area to Palos Verdes and Long Beach.



Declaration Activity

DR-4759 Washington

- The Biden administration on Tuesday announced a major disaster declaration that orders federal assistance for victims of devastating wildfires in Spokane County last summer.
- The two wind-driven blazes swept across the county in August, scorching more than 21,000 acres, destroying hundreds of homes, causing millions of dollars in property damage, and claiming two lives.
