#### **Tropical Activity** Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- Located offshore of the east coast of Florida.
- Environmental conditions appear generally favorable for additional development; a tropical depression could form.
- Regardless of development, heavy rainfall could • produce localized flash flooding over portions of Florida through mid-week.
- Formation chance through 48 hours Medium (40%).
- Formation chance through 7 days Medium (40%).



### **Flooding Activity**

#### Eastern U.S.

- Heavy rains swept across the northeastern United States on July 14, prompting a State of Emergency in New Jersey due to widespread flash floods.
- New Jersey Governor Phil Murphy declared a State of Emergency at 7:30PM LT, urging residents to stay off the roads and seek shelter.
- Swift water rescue teams were de-



- ployed to multiple locations in Union County and surrounding municipalities.
- New York City recorded its second-wettest hour on record, receiving 2.07 inches of rain between 7PM and 8PM local time (LT).
- Water rescues, flooding in subway stations, and hazardous road conditions were reported across the Tri-State Area as heavy rains impacted the region.
- A flood warning was issued for Staten Island, which received approximately 4–6 inches of rain, according to New York City's emergency notification system.
- Washington D.C., Baltimore, New York City and Hartford, Connecticut, were just a few of the • major cities under Flash Flood Warnings.
- The FOX Forecast Center said rain will become more scattered for Tuesday and Wednesday.
- By Thursday, a new wave of rain will move into the East.
- Storms will start in the Midwest and eventually move into the East as another cold front will come crashing through which will only help stack the rain totals even higher across areas.
