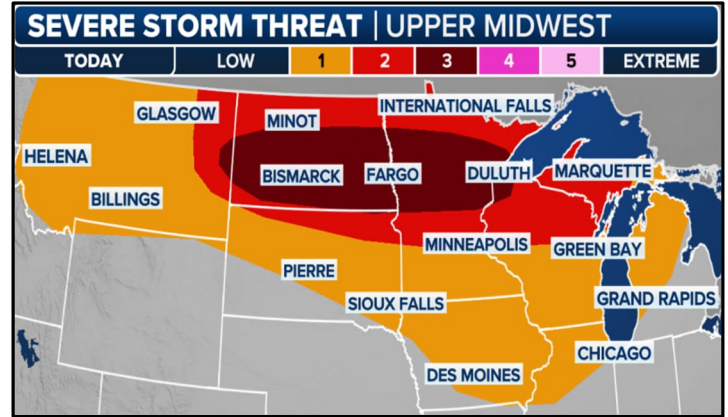

## Severe Weather Outlook

### Upper Midwest

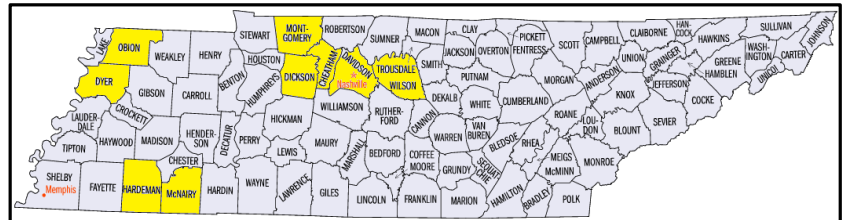
- Thunderstorm Watches and Warnings were issued Friday morning across Minnesota and parts of Iowa.
- The first of two rounds of severe weather that are expected to play out across the northern tier of the country Friday.
- Storms are packing high winds, heavy rain and lots of lightning.
- The second round of storms comes Friday evening as more storms develop from Montana into Minnesota.
- Expected to continue through the overnight hours, eventually arriving in the Upper Peninsula of Michigan.
- A strong tornado or two will be possible in the areas of Bismarck and Fargo if supercell thunderstorms are able to form.



## Disaster Declaration Activity

### DR 4878 - Tennessee

- On June 19, President Donald Trump approved a major declaration for the following counties: Cheatham, Davidson, Dickson, Dyer, Hardeman, McNairy, Montgomery, Obion and Wilson.
- From April 2–6, 2025, a slow-moving weather system and a stationary front caused widespread and devastating tornado outbreak and historic, life-threatening flash flooding across Tennessee.
- The National Weather Service confirmed that 19 tornadoes affected western and central Tennessee during the weather event.
- There were ten weather-related fatalities.
- In addition to the devastating outbreak of tornadoes, this event brought up to 15 inches of rain in some areas, causing severe flooding and flash flooding throughout the state.
- Straight-line winds with gusts up to 90 mph caused significant damage to property in multiple counties.
- On April 17, 2025, Gov. Lee requested Individual Assistance (IA) for the following 15 counties: Cheatham, Davidson, Dickson, Dyer, Grundy, Hardeman, Hickman, Humphreys, Lewis, McNairy, Montgomery, Obion, Perry, Sumner, and Wilson counties.
