

Severe Weather Outlook Plains & Upper Midwest

- The Midwest is facing a prolonged period of severe weather through Wednesday, with the FOX Forecast Center warning of multiple rounds of intense thunderstorms capable of producing tornadoes, very large hail, damaging winds and significant flash flooding.
- The threat extends from Minnesota, including Minneapolis-St. Paul, southwestward to the central Plains and eastward into parts of the Great Lakes region.
- After Monday, the days of severe storms will continue with an increased threat of flash flooding.



Flooding Activity

West Virginia

- At least five people have been killed, and four others remain missing after dangerous flash flooding impacted Wheeling and surrounding communities in West Virginia over the weekend, according to the Wheeling-Ohio County Emergency Management Agency.
- "There were roughly 3 to 4 inches of water that fell in the area in less than an hour. That's very, very difficult to deal with," West Virginia Gov. Patrick Morrisey said.
- Search and rescue efforts are resuming Monday morning and officials continue to urge people to stay off local roads.
- Most of the impacts from the flash flooding were in the northern and central parts of the state.
- Numerous Flash Flood Warnings and a rare Flash Flood Emergency were issued by the National Weather Service office in Pittsburgh late Saturday night and early Sunday morning.
- Wheeling Creek rose 7 feet in under 2 hours, according to the FOX Forecast Center.
- Thousands of power outages have also been reported.
- A Flash Flood Emergency was issued for the community of Fairmont, West Virginia in Marion County.
- The National Weather Service said between 1.5 and 3 inches of rain had fallen in a short time in Marion County.
- Multiple water rescues were reported by local law enforcement in Fairmont and an apartment building partially collapsed.
- The governor announced an emergency declaration for Marion County on Sunday evening.
- FOX Forecast Center said more rain will continue to fall across the flooded area through midweek.
