



Tropical Activity Atlantic - Tropical Storm Erin

- Maximum sustained winds within Tropical Storm Erin have held steady at 45 mph.
- Forecasters say Tropical Storm Erin is expected to start to gain strength starting on Wednesday and will likely become a hurricane either Thursday or Friday.
- Located about 1,400 miles to the east of the northern Leeward Islands and is moving off to the west at 20 mph.
- General motion is expected to continue into Thursday, with a west-northwestward motion starting Thursday night and continuing into the weekend.
- NHC said the center of Tropical Storm Erin is forecast to move near or just north of the northern Leeward Islands over the weekend.
- Forecasters say it could be a major hurricane (Category 3 or higher) with winds of at least 115 mph.
- Swells generated by Tropical Storm Erin are expected to begin impacting portions of the northern Leeward Islands, the Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico by this weekend.

Atlantic - Disturbance 1

- A tropical wave near the east coast of the Yucatan Peninsula is producing disorganized showers and thunderstorms.
- This disturbance is forecast to move west northwestward and cross the Yucatan Peninsula today with no significant increase in organization.
- Some development is possible after it emerges across the southwestern Gulf beginning Thursday.
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 7 days: Low (20%)
