Severe Weather Outlook Central Plains and Eastern U.S.

- Severe weather is expected to develop across the central U.S. from the Midwest to the Great Lakes region on Wednesday.
- Millions of people in cities like St. Louis, Indianapolis, Chicago and Detroit are on alert for powerful storms that could be capable of producing damaging wind gusts, large hail and even some tornadoes.
- Severe weather threats are expected to continue for the rest of the week, putting the mid-Atlantic, Northeast and New England on alert by Thursday.
- NOAA's Storm Prediction Center (SPC) has zeroed in on the Midwest and Ohio Valley, which is where the highest risk for storms is forecast to occur.
- More than 15 million people in cities like Indianapolis and Fort Wayne in Indiana, Toledo and Dayton in Ohio and Louisville in Kentucky are at risk of severe weather.
