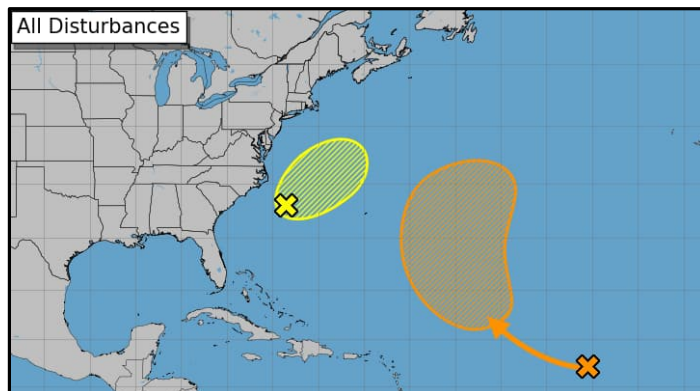

## Tropical Activity

### Atlantic - Disturbance #1

- Area of low pressure located a couple of hundred miles off the coast of North Carolina.
- Producing a few disorganized showers and thunderstorms.
- Development is expected to be slow to occur over the next day or two while it moves northeastward at 10 to 15 mph.
- Likely to merge with a front over the weekend, ending its chances for tropical or subtropical development.
- Formation chance - 48 hour: Low (10%); 7-day: Low (10%)



### Atlantic - Disturbance #2

- Tropical wave over the central tropical Atlantic is producing minimal shower activity.
- Development of this system appears unlikely during the next day or two.
- A tropical depression could form during the early or middle part of next week while the system moves northwestward to northward across the central tropical and subtropical Atlantic.
- Formation chance 48 hour: Low (0%); 7-day: Medium (50%)

## Wildfire Activity

### California

- Parts of Los Angeles County were evacuated in the early morning hours Friday after the fast-moving wildfire, named the Canyon Fire.
- Firefighters said in a late night social media update that some 2,700 people had been evacuated in LA County.
- The wildfire has consumed 4,856 acres and is currently not contained.
- Roughly 14,000 people and 5,000 buildings are covered by current evacuation orders, according to fire officials.
- The fast-moving brush fire broke out on Thursday around Lake Piru in Ventura County growing to nearly 2,000 acres during the initial hours of the firefight.
- Initial evacuations were centered between Hopper Mountain National Wildlife Refuge and Interstate 5.
