Severe Weather Outlook Great Lakes

- A first round of severe storms rumbled through parts of the Midwest Monday evening, as the main severe weather threat will shift east Tuesday, covering more than 25 million people across the Great Lakes.
- Tuesday's threat also extends back into parts of Missouri, Kansas, Oklahoma and the Texas Panhandle, indicative of that new weather pattern beginning to take shape.
- Severe thunderstorms were ongoing over Michigan early Tuesday, with the National Weather Service (NWS) warning of large damaging hail.
- NOAA's Storm Prediction Center has issued a Level 2 out of 5 risk of severe thunderstorms for much of the Great Lakes Tuesday covering the Chicago, Fort Wayne, Indiana, Detroit, Cleveland and Buffalo, New York metro areas.
- The FOX Forecast Center said hail will be the primary threat, though an isolated tornado cannot be ruled out despite a lower overall tornado risk.
- These storms are also producing heavy rain which could cause flash flooding across parts of western New York, the Adirondacks and western Pennsylvania.
