March 11, 2022

Severe Weather Outlook

- Severe thunderstorms, including a threat of tornadoes, and flooding rain will hammer parts of the Southeast through Saturday.
- Some severe weather is possible from this cluster of storms as it tracks toward northern Florida and southern Georgia during the day.
- Beginning Friday night, though, severe thunderstorms may become more numerous and last into at least Saturday morning.
- Damaging wind gusts and tornadoes are possible in these severe thunderstorms Friday night into early Saturday, especially in the Florida Big Bend and in South Georgia.
- A continuation of Friday night's severe weather will likely be ongoing Saturday morning near the Southeast coast, from eastern Virginia to the eastern Carolinas, southeast Georgia and northern Florida.
- Damaging winds and some tornadoes are possible from this severe weather.
- The threat of severe weather will likely end during the morning hour or early afternoon hours for the areas along the Southeast coast but could continue later into the afternoon hours for locations farther south into the Florida Peninsula.
- Flash flooding is also a threat. Over 2 inches of additional rain is expected in parts of north Florida and South Georgia through Saturday.
