



WSP USA INSPECTION SERVICES DISASTER AWARENESS REPORT

February 25, 2022

2nd Spring Flood Outlook

- Along the Red River in northwestern Minnesota and eastern North Dakota, there is a moderately high threat for significant snowmelt flooding.
- Lingering 2021 drought conditions mean that surface storage has room for snowmelt infiltration, if thaw is gentle.
- Snowfall/snow water equivalent through late February is somewhat above long-term mid-winter normal amounts.
- The spring flood risk is near to slightly above normal for the Mississippi River, and near to slightly below normal for local tributary rivers across the NWS Quad Cities Hydrologic Service Area.
- There has been a modest increase in probabilities for minor and moderate flooding on the Mississippi River, compared to the first outlook, and little or no change in flood probabilities for tributary rivers.
- Snow cover and snow water equivalent are below normal across much of the area, which decreases the overall flood threat. However, the northern reaches of the Mississippi River basin are above normal. A rapid snowmelt occurring over still frozen ground would increase the flood threat on the Mississippi River this spring. A slow, steady melt would decrease the threat.
- River levels in the upper Mississippi watershed are currently running near normal, providing more capacity to handle any heavy spring rains.
- The third spring flood outlook will be released on March 10th.
