




April 15, 2024

Severe Weather Outlook

- AccuWeather meteorologists warn that the severe weather threat includes the potential for tornadoes, large hail, powerful wind gusts and flooding rainfall.
- “Supported by an influx of Gulf moisture, Monday’s severe threat will bring the risk of isolated tornadoes, hail, flooding rainfall and damaging winds to the Plains,” AccuWeather Meteorologist Alexander Duffus stated.
- Severe thunderstorm risk could be further elevated to start the week, as Monday’s risk may peak during the nighttime hours in many metropolitan areas across the Plains.
- Cities that sit squarely within the risk for severe thunderstorms include Wichita Falls, Texas; Oklahoma City; and Wichita, Kansas.
- As the storm and its trailing cold front surge eastward into the day on Tuesday, the severe weather threat zone will shift right along with it.
- Spanning from southern Arkansas into the western Great Lakes and Upper Midwest, another round of potentially life-threatening thunderstorms is expected to track across the nation’s midsection.
- Once again, hail, damaging wind gusts and even a few tornadoes are possible in places like St. Louis, Chicago and Memphis.
- A wide swath of 40-60 mph gusts can span from eastern Arizona through the central Plains on Monday, with a zone of 60-80 mph gusts in the mountainous terrain and adjacent High Plains of New Mexico and Texas and a second area of higher gusts likely in and around Cheyenne, Wyoming.
- The severe thunderstorm risk could continue into midweek across portions of the Midwest, focusing over the Ohio Valley.
