

## Tornado Activity Florida

- A strong storm system brought tornadoes to Pinellas, Hillsborough and Polk Counties Wednesday afternoon.
- The "large, extremely dangerous tornado" ripped across the three counties, beginning just before 4 p.m. Wednesday, according to the National Weather Service, covering more than 50 miles in about two hours.
- There was extensive damage in Pinellas County, according to the Tampa Bay Times. But there were no confirmed fatalities or serious injuries.
- The tornado weakened over Tampa Bay and formed again in Polk County on the other side, according to the paper.
- Approximately 25 structures have been reported as damaged in Pinellas Park as well as 3 homes in Polk County.
- Nearly 14,000 homes and businesses were without power in the county as of about 6:30 p.m. yesterday, according to poweroutage.us.
