

## Declaration Request Georgia

- On Friday, April 16<sup>th</sup>, the governor of Georgia sent a letter requesting a major disaster declaration for the severe storms and tornadoes that occurred March 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup>. He is requesting individual assistance for Coweta County.
- The EF-4 tornado was on the ground for 53 minutes and traveled 38.88 miles across three counties, reaching a maximum width of 1,850 yards (just over 1 mile) as it reached its peak intensity on the southwest side of Newnan.
- It was the first EF4 tornado to occur in Georgia since the 2011 Ringgold tornado.
- Sens. Jon Ossoff and Raphael Warnock both toured the damage in Newnan Saturday. The two promised to petition the Biden Administration and FEMA for federal disaster relief.



• According to Coweta County Emergency Management officials, if approved help could come in the next two to six weeks.
