



June 13, 2023

Severe Weather Outlook

- Parts of Texas are once again in the threat zone for severe weather as supercells will be capable of tornadoes, large hail and damaging winds during the afternoon Tuesday and into the evening hours. The threat spreads into Arkansas and northern Louisiana Tuesday, then continuing overnight into parts of Alabama and Georgia.
- Larger cities in Texas, like Dallas, Fort Worth, Arlington and Plano, in addition to Shreveport, Louisiana, Jackson, Mississippi and Birmingham, Alabama – even as far east as Savannah, Georgia, are all in the risk areas that could see severe storms Tuesday.
- Already, some severe storms bringing large hail were rolling across the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex early Tuesday morning and a Severe Thunderstorm Watch is in effect across the southern Plains, including Dallas, until 10 a.m. CDT.
- Emergency management officials in Dallas even activated their Outdoor Warning System just before 7 a.m. CDT due to the threat of large hail.
- "We've had a couple severe storms pop up, so it's isolated," FOX Weather meteorologist Britta Merwin said. "But the storms that we're tracking are really providing a punch."
- By Wednesday, the corridor of thunderstorms may push its way toward the Southeast, rather than the Plains states. Cities such as Birmingham, Alabama, and Atlanta, Georgia, may be threatened by these storms.
