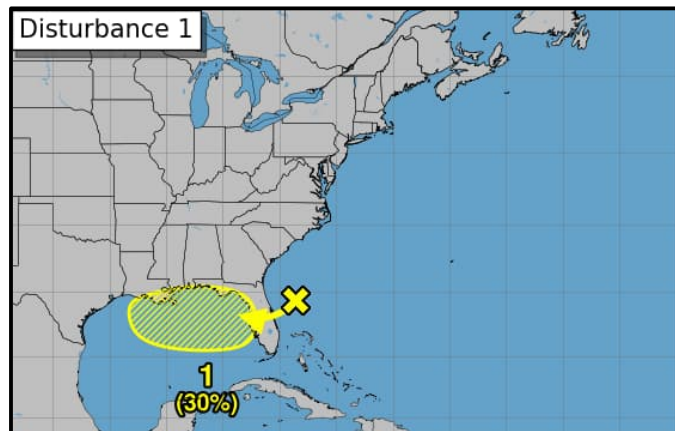

Tropical Activity

Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- An area of low pressure located offshore the east coast of Florida is producing disorganized showers and thunderstorms.
- Forecasted to move westward across Florida during the next day or so, and into the north-eastern Gulf by late Tuesday.
- Environmental conditions appear favorable and some gradual development of this system is possible while it moves westward to west-northwestward across the northeastern and north-central portions of the Gulf during the middle to latter part of this week.
- Heavy rainfall could produce localized flash flooding over portions of Florida and the north-central Gulf coast through the middle to latter portion of this week.
- Formation chance through 48 hours – Low (10%).
- Formation chance through 7 days – Low (30%).



Flooding Activity

Texas

- Heavy rain and a new wave of flooding in central Texas on Sunday prompted swift water rescues and hampered the grim search for victims of the deluge that swept through the region more than a week ago, killing at least 132 people and leaving devastation in its wake.
- Texas Gov. Greg Abbott said water rescues were taking place in San Saba, Lampasas, and Schleicher counties, and evacuations were ordered in several communities as well.
- The San Saba River reached about 30.58 feet on Sunday after overnight and continuing rains.
- Lampasas, located northeast of Kerr County, saw its river rise from a normal 10-foot level to over 30 feet, leading to widespread road closures and evacuations.
- The FOX Forecast Center said the chances of storms will start to decrease on Monday, heading into Tuesday. However, even though fewer storms are expected overall, any storm that does develop could bring a quick 1-2 inches of rain.
