

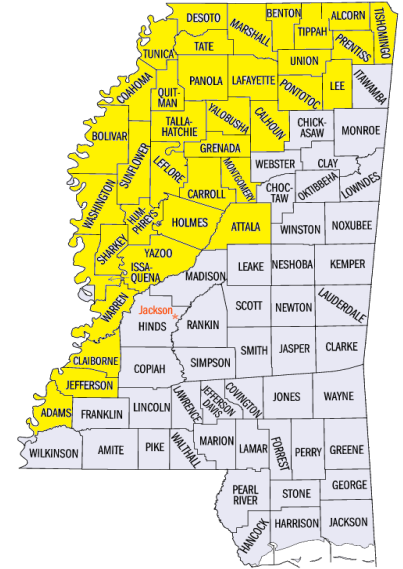

February 4, 2026

Disaster Declaration Request Mississippi

- On February 3, 2026, Governor Tate Reeves announced that he has requested a Major Disaster Declaration for multiple counties impacted by the severe winter storms that swept across the state from January 23 – January 27, 2026.
- A state of emergency was declared beginning on January 23.
- At least 25 people in Mississippi have died due to Winter Storm Fern that hit the state on Jan. 23.
- Response efforts remain underway with over 30,000 residents and businesses without power as of Wednesday morning.
- More than 189,000 customers in Mississippi lost power during the peak of the storm with thousands of power poles broken.
- As of February 2, the Mississippi Emergency Management agency had received reports from 51 counties which indicated 369 homes, 26 businesses, and 20 farms have been damaged, destroyed or affected statewide.
- Additionally, 62 public roads have sustained major damage and 20 have sustained minor damage. Those numbers are expected to fluctuate as damage assessments continue.
