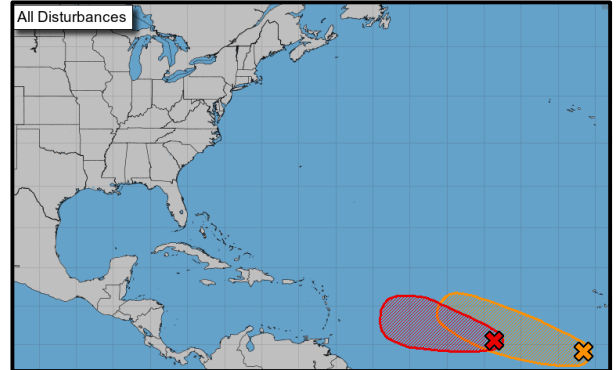
Tropical Activity

Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- Located between Africa and the Lesser Antilles moving W at 15-20 mph.
- Could become a tropical depression later today.
- Formation chance - 48 hours: High (near 100%); 7-day: High (near 100%)

Atlantic – Disturbance 2

- Located several hundred miles SSW of the Cabo Verde Islands moving W at 10-15 mph.
- Tropical depression could form within the next few days.
- Formation chance - 48 hours: Low (30%); 7-day: Medium (40%)



2023 Atlantic Hurricane Season Forecast (Updated)

- A new outlook from The Weather Company piled onto forecasters' expectations for a slightly above average, but more unpredictable 2023 Atlantic Hurricane Season.
- The new outlook from The Weather Company and Atmospheric G2 is for 17 named storms, nine hurricanes and four hurricanes reaching at least Category 3 status. This is an increase of one named storm, one hurricane and one major hurricane since their previous outlook, which was released in mid-May.
- This increase in named storms and the overall outlook of 17 named storms includes an unnamed subtropical storm that formed in January but was not added to the official records until May.
- Since mid-spring, we've been suggesting that two competing factors will battle for control this year: a strengthening El Niño and extremely warm Atlantic water temperatures.
- But that balance is continuing to shift in favor of the warm Atlantic waters as those waters progressively warm relative to average in the Gulf of Mexico and subtropical Atlantic.
- We've already had two named storms this season through mid-June.
