## Tornado Activity Michigan

- Four tornadoes touched down in Michigan during the afternoon and early evening, leaving damage paths across parts of Cass, St. Joseph, Branch and Calhoun counties.
- According to the National Weather Service, a tornado first



touched down northwest of Runkle Street and Conrad Road, destroying a garage and damaging the front of a home. The Cass County Sheriff confirmed a 12-year-old boy was killed there during the storm.

- The tornado moved northeast, toppling trees and causing minor roof damage as it crossed Yankee Street east of Dailey Road.
- A little more than 10 minutes after the tornado in Cass County, a second tornado touched down in Three Rivers.
- As it tracked through the heart of Three Rivers and crossed the St. Joseph River, the tornado caused additional EF-1 and isolated EF-2 damage to homes, businesses and a hospital, as well as a lumber yard and cemetery.
- At approximately 4:33 p.m., a third tornado touched down on the northwest side of Union Lake in northern Branch County and quickly intensified as it tracked along the shoreline.
- Videos showed a multiple-vortex tornado at its peak near Prairie Rose Lane and Tuttle Road, where homes and cottages were destroyed and debris was scattered or lofted to the northeast.
- About 15 minutes after the Union City tornado, a fourth and final tornado moved through southern Calhoun County between Tekonsha and Homer. It was rated EF0, with maximum winds of 85 mph.
- The twister uprooted several trees and snapped already weakened trunks as it traveled nearly 3 miles toward N Drive South, where it eventually lifted.
- March 6, 2026, was the deadliest day for tornadoes in Michigan since May 13, 1980, when five people were killed by a tornado that tore through the heart of Kalamazoo.
