Flooding Activity Northwest

- A powerful atmospheric river slamming the Northwest is fueling flooding over numerous rivers in Washington state as they reach major flood stage.
- Late Wednesday night, Skagit County, one of the northernmost in the state, announced that it was experiencing major flooding and urged all



people living within the 100-year flood plain to evacuate to higher ground.

- On December 10, Gov. Bob Ferguson declared a statewide emergency amid potentially catastrophic flooding.
- Washington Gov. Bob Ferguson activated the National Guard to respond to requests for help. Gov. Ferguson said 100 National Guard members would be active and available Wednesday evening, with an additional 200 set to arrive by Thursday.
- Flood Warnings have been issued for the Wenatchee River at Peshastin, Entiat River near Ardenvoir, and Stehekin River at Stehekin.
- Major flooding is likely between Leavenworth and Wenatchee, as the Wenatchee River exceeds
 15 ft for the first time since 2006.
- Minor flooding in the Entiat Valley is expected as the Entiat River exceeds 7.5 ft.
- The Puyallup River near Orting, entered Major Flood Stage with reports of flooded roads.
- Evacuation orders have been issued there for surrounding streets which may continue to see flooding through Thursday.
