Snow Mid - Atlantic

- The FOX Forecast Center confidence continues to grow that other parts of Virginia, as well as northern North Carolina, Maryland and Delaware, will see their first snow of the season.
- The heaviest snow is expected in southern Virginia, including Richmond and Roanoke.



- Snowfall totals could reach 4 inches in Roanoke and Blacksburg; Winter Weather Advisories have been issued for southern Virginia and northern North Carolina.
- Larger areas from Virginia to Massachusetts could see a coating to an inch of snow Friday into Saturday.
- A lobe of arctic air has been making its way east across the Midwest this week and will reach the Northeast by Thursday.
- Temperatures for places like Richmond, Virginia and Raleigh, North Carolina could drop to the low 30s or upper 20s on Thursday night.
- Also, a storm system that's delivering heavy rain across the southeastern U.S. is expected to ride
 up the East Coast and meet the frigid air Friday, setting the stage for the potential snow and ice
 storm.
