

Tornado Activity

Texas

- The National Weather Service has now confirmed two tornadoes touched down in the northwest part of the Houston area on Monday.
- One tornado is rated an EF-2. That one hit the Klein area with estimated winds of 115 miles per hour.
- The NWS said the tornado touched down Monday afternoon between 2:15 p.m. and just before 3, starting east of Elfranco Lee Park near the Sam Houston Tollway. It then carved near continued paths across southeast Houston, Pasadena, Deer Park, and Baytown.
- The NWS said most of the damage has fallen in the EF-0 and EF-1 range; however, pockets of EF-2 damage have been seen, and three high-tension electrical towers were flattened near the Houston Ship Channel which has pointed to EF-3 strengths.
- The other twister hit Riata Ranch in Cypress with estimated winds of 105 miles per hour. That makes it an EF-1 rated tornado.
- Officials say 100 homes had damaged or were destroyed. No fatalities have been reported, but there were several minor injuries.
