Tropical Activity Atlantic – Tropical Storm Lorenzo

- Tropical Storm Lorenzo is maintaining its strength after it formed early Monday in the central tropical Atlantic.
- Tropical Storm Lorenzo currently has maximum sustained winds of 60 mph. A tropical storm has maximum sustained winds between 39 and 73 mph.



- Lorenzo is more than 1,300 miles west of the Cabo Verde Islands, located off the western coast of Africa, and is moving northwestward at 15 mph.
- Lorenzo will likely perform an elongated clockwise loop in the middle of the Atlantic Ocean, getting wrapped around a large area of high pressure, rather than tracking straight out to sea.
- Expected to move northwestward on Tuesday before turning northward Tuesday night and then moving toward the northeast Wednesday and Thursday
