Severe Storms Activity

- Severe thunderstorms raked parts of the Midwest and Northeast, including a derecho in Wisconsin and Illinois and a swarm of tornadoes in Pennsylvania, New Jersey and Ohio.
- Supercell thunderstorms spawned multiple tornadoes Thursday afternoon and evening in the Ohio Valley and Mid-Atlantic states.
- Early Thursday evening, multiple damaging tornadoes tore through parts of eastern Pennsylvania and New Jersey.
 At least five people were injured ofter at least two ternedoes rinned through parts of
- At least five people were injured after at least two tornadoes ripped through parts of Pennsylvania on Thursday. There were a total of six reports of tornadoes in Pennsylvania and Ohio, though some are still unconfirmed.
- At least one tornado, possibly more, tracked through Bucks County, Pennsylvania, damaging structures in Buckingham Township, before crossing into the Trenton, New Jersey, metro area. This prompted the National Weather Service in Mount Holly, New Jersey, to issue its first-ever "particularly dangerous situation" tornado warning.

<u>Ohio</u>

- A small tornado spawned by a storm that blew through the Erie region early Thursday afternoon damaged buildings and toppled a tractor-trailer during a brief touch-down near Cochranton in Crawford County, according to the National Weather Service in Cleveland.
- One destructive tornado tore through the village of Wintersville, Ohio, just west of Steubenville near the West Virginia state line around 6 p.m.



- Numerous trees were uprooted, two barns had their roofs blown off, a tractor-trailer was blown off Route 173, a detached garage was blown in a field and destroyed and a cornfield was flattened, according to the statement.
- The bulk of the damage was in Wayne Township, with some damage reported in neighboring Randolph Township, Scott Schell, chief of the Cochranton Volunteer Fire Department & Ambulance Service, said Friday.
- He said multiple barns and houses were damaged, with two barns and a garage destroyed, and a roof was ripped off a barn on a dairy farm.

Wisconsin


- A sixth tornado has been confirmed in far northwestern Wisconsin from storms that slammed Wisconsin Wednesday night and extended into Thursday.
- The governor, Tony Evers announced a state of emergency Thursday, letting communities seek backup from the state if the need arises. But no communities had called for assistance



- as of 12:30 p.m., as per Andrew Beckett, a spokesman for Wisconsin Emergency Management.
- A county emergency manager said 10 to 12 homes were damaged.
