

Tropical Activity Atlantic - Disturbance #1

- A non-tropical area of low pressure located a few hundred miles southeast of Nova Scotia, Canada is producing disorganized shower and thunderstorms to the west of its center.
- Expected to move northward over cooler waters by Wednesday, ending its chances for tropical development.
- Formation chance through 48 hours Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 7 days Low (10%)



Atlantic - Disturbance #2

- A surface trough near the coast of Louisiana is producing a broad area of disorganized showers and thunderstorms.
- Development of this system is not anticipated before it moves inland later today.
- Locally heavy rainfall could produce flash flooding across portions of the northern Gulf coast over the next day or so.
- Formation chance through 48 hours Low (0%)
- Formation chance through 7 days Low (0%)

Atlantic - Tropical Storm Erin

- Tropical Storm Erin formed in the central Atlantic Ocean on the morning of August 11th and is forecast to become the first major hurricane of the 2025 Atlantic hurricane season.
- Located about 560 miles west-northwest of the Cabo Verde islands and moving off to the west at 22 mph.
- That motion is expected to continue for the next several days with a gradual slowdown in forward speed and a turn to the west-northwest.



- Maximum sustained winds remain at 45 mph with some higher gusts.
- The latest forecast track shows Erin moving north of Puerto Rico by this weekend.
