

Atmospheric River California

- An atmospheric river is forecast to hit the California coast starting with Northern California on Nov. 12 and moving down to Southern California the next day.
- Rain showers, thunderstorms, and flooding could be in store for parts of the coast as showers are expected to last for about two days.
- Wednesday, Nov. 12, will kick off the rainstorms in the Bay Area, according to the National Weather Service.
- The storm is expected to continue into Nov. 14 with light rain showers.
- Californians should also be wary of strong winds blowing debris and making driving more difficult.
- San Luis Obispo and Santa Barbara counties will experience the peak of the storm early on the morning of Nov. 13, and Ventura and Los Angeles counties will see the peak in the late morning.
- Storms could bring between 2 and 4 inches of rain to the mountains and hills, and between 1 and 2 inches to the lowlands.
