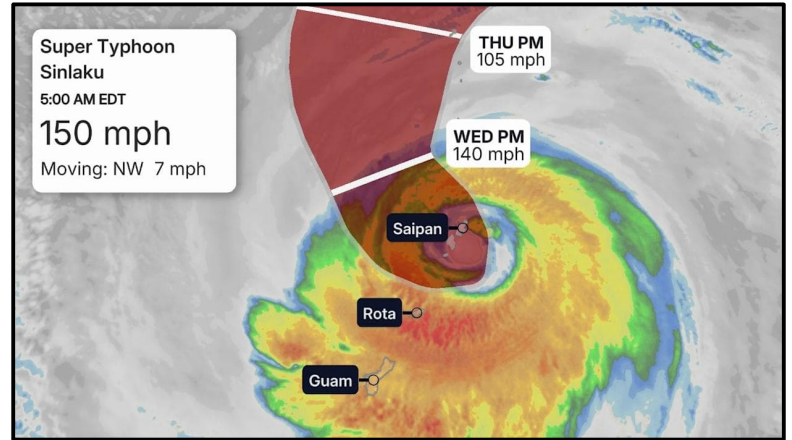

## Tropical Activity

### Super Typhoon Sinlaku (CAT-4)

- Super Typhoon Sinlaku, the most powerful storm recorded globally in 2026, is projected to make landfall in the Northern Mariana Islands on Tuesday, April 14, 2026, bringing destructive winds and life-threatening floods to the region.
- Currently located 25 miles SSE of Saipan and 120 miles NE of Guam.
- Maximum sustained winds 150 mph moving NNW at 4 mph.
- Guam remains under a tropical storm warning, with the U.S. Coast Guard issuing high wind and flood alerts.
- Coastal inundation of up to 3 feet in Guam and 4 to 7 feet across Tinian and Saipan is possible.
- The cyclone will bring heavy rainfall through the week, with totals of up to 12 inches in Guam, 10 to 20 inches in Rota, and upwards of 15 to 25 inches across Tinian and Saipan.



## Severe Weather Outlook

- The severe weather threat has expanded Tuesday, covering more than 130 million people, spanning more than 1,500 miles from the Big Bend of Texas through parts of New England.
- A Level 3 out of 5 severe storm risk is in effect across parts of eastern Iowa, southern Wisconsin and northern Illinois, including Chicago and Milwaukee.
- These storms are expected to produce large hail, 2-3 inches in diameter, beginning mid-to-late afternoon.
- Conditions will be ripe for supercell thunderstorms capable of producing strong EF-2+ tornadoes along or south of the warm front around sunset.
- In the southern theater of Tuesday's threat, severe storms capable of producing tornadoes are forecast over Oklahoma and West Texas.
- Additional strong storms, mainly producing strong wind gusts, are possible across parts of the interior Northeast.
- A second round of severe thunderstorms will ignite from Texas to New York on Wednesday, with the flood threat mounting for parts of the Midwest and Great Lakes, which have seen several consecutive days of heavy rain.
