Severe Weather Outlook Southern Plains

- The FOX Forecast Center said the threat of storms and flooding rain will ramp up starting Tuesday afternoon.
- The highest threat being located across portions of West Texas and western Oklahoma.
- Cities such as Lubbock, Amarillo, Midland and Odessa in Texas, as well as Hutchinson in Kansas are at risk of severe weather.



Hail and damaging winds will be the main threats from any severe thunderstorms that develop Tuesday, but there is also a low chance of some tornadoes.

Disaster Update DR-4860 Kentucky

- The Federal Emergency Management Agency has extended the deadline for personal assistance following severe storms and flooding in eastern Kentucky, officials said.
- Homeowners and renters that experienced damage to their property during the fatal storms now have until Monday, May 25 to apply for assistance, according to a news release
- Currently, there are Disaster Recovery Centers are in Pikeville, Inez, Eastern and Belfry.

Disaster Declaration Request Tennessee

- On April 18th, Governor Bill Lee reguested Individual Assistance for 14 of the following counties: Cheatham, Davidson, Dickson, Dyer, Grundy, Hardeman, Hickman, Humphreys, Lewis,
 - Montgomery, Obion, Perry, Sumner, Wilson.



- On April 2nd, Governor Bill Lee, TEMA Director Patrick C. Sheehan issued a State of Emergency ahead of expected significant severe storms and flooding.
- From April 2–7, 2025, a slow-moving weather system and a stationary front caused both a widespread and devastating tornado outbreak and historic, life-threatening flash flooding.
- The slow progression of the weather system also resulted in days of heavy rainfall and caused catastrophic flash flooding across much of the Ohio Valley.
