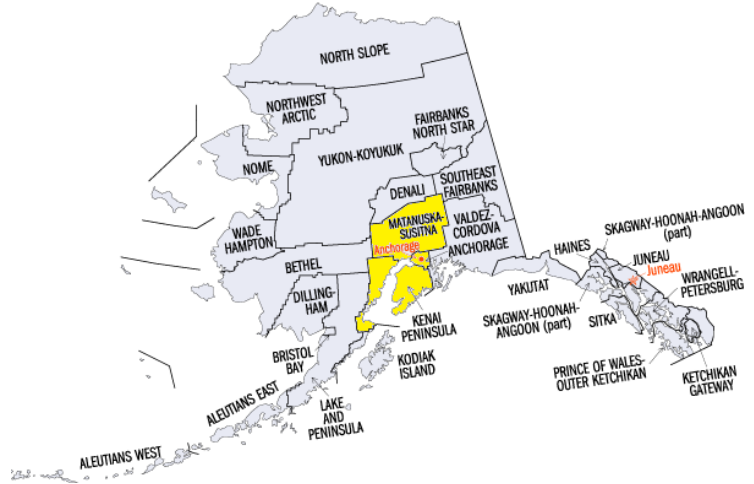

## Declaration Activity

### Alaska

- President Trump has approved a long-sought federal major disaster declaration stemming from Southcentral Alaska's Nov. 30 earthquake, freeing funds for people affected by the massive 7.0 temblor.
- "The president's action makes Federal funding available to affected individuals in the **Municipality of Anchorage, Matanuska-Susitna Borough, and Kenai Peninsula Borough,**" White House officials wrote in a Thursday statement.
- At a news conference called by Gov. Mike Dunleavy just after the federal declaration Thursday afternoon, Alaska Adjutant Gen. Torrence Saxe said 300 to 400 federal officials will be heading to Alaska to assess the extent of earthquake damage and potential federal relief.
- Alaska's congressional delegation quickly congratulated Trump on Thursday's decision, saying that it will also unlock help to the state as it deals with damage from the quake's nearly 8,000 aftershocks.
- Thousands of Alaskans have already applied for state disaster relief, with current Gov. Mike Dunleavy extending the deadline to do so until Feb. 28.
